The petitioners seek protection of life and liberty from the hands of private respondent nos. 4 to 7, who are stated to be the relatives of petitioner no. 1.

Mr. Rajat Dogra, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of Mr. K.S. Brar, Advocate for respondents no. 4 to 7.

On 20.08.2020, interim protection was granted and directions were issued that a meeting would be convened with respondent no. 4, the father of petitioner no. 1 as he wanted to ensure that she was well kept and safe.

Mr. B.S. Sewak, Addl. A.G., Punjab, on instructions from ASI Ravinder, submits that in pursuance of the said directions, the parties had put in appearance before the SHO-respondent no. 3 on 28.08.2020. The statement of respondent no. 4 as such was recorded, who has now accepted the marriage of the petitioners.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the respondent-State to ensure that the petitioners are not harassed at the hands of the private respondents and their life and liberty is protected in case there is any threat to them at the hands of the private respondents or their agents on account of the marriage.
