1. The Petitioner is aggrieved by the action of the Food Corporation of Indian (FCI) rejecting his Technical Bid and FCI's order dated 3rd August, 2020, rejecting his representation.
2. The fact of the matter is that despite being an assessee the Petitioner, in the tender document, claimed himself to be a "Non-Assessee". This is factually untrue and led to rejection of his Technical Bid.
3. Counsel for the Petitioner is unable to dispute the above fact. That being the position, the Court is unable to find any fault with the impugned order dated 3rd August, 2020 of the FCI rejecting the Petitioner's representation.
4. As regards the complaint filed by the Petitioner against Respondent No.3, who has been awarded the tender, learned Counsel for Respondents No. 1 & 2, on instructions, states that the said complaint has been found to be without basis.
5. In the circumstances, there is no merit in this petition, the same is dismissed.
