The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.59 dated 20.04.2020 under Sections 15/25/29 NDPS Act registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 28.10.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the IO concerned, does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submits that his custodial interrogation is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 28.10.2020 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
