The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.190 dated 04.07.2020 registered under Sections 307/326/341/379B/482/148/149/120-B/188 IPC, Section 3 of Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and Section 51(b) of Disaster Management Act 2005, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

On 19.08.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that no specific role has been attributed to the

petitioner, especially with regard to the injury, which has been caused by him. His contention is that as per the allegation, the petitioner had a baseball bat, with which he had attacked. He further states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation and cooperate with the same, including get recovered the alleged weapon i.e. baseball bat.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.B.S.Sewak, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer, Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar, on 21.08.2020 at 10.00 A.M. to join investigation.

In case the petitioner is arrested, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as contained in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. He will join the investigation as and when required.

To come up for further consideration on 08.09.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Amritpal admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 19.08.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when directed to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
