1. Applicant-wife seeks transfer of petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 bearing HMA/173/2019 titled as “Amritpal Singh Vs. Kirandeep Kaur” pending in the Court of Learned Additional District Judge, Sangrur to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is residing in Chandigarh. Her parents have already expired. Her only brother is living in Abohar with her Massi. There is nobody to accompany her to travel. The distance between Chandigarh and Sangrur is 100 Kms. Therefore, it is difficult for her to go to Sangrur on each date of hearing.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent appears and submits that he has no objection if the petition in question is

transferred to Chandigarh.

4. Without going into the merits of the application and keeping in view the consent given by both the learned counsel for the parties, the present application is allowed. The petition in question pending before the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Sangrur is ordered to be withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to the District Judge, Chandigarh for its disposal in accordance with law by the Court concerned.
