Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.50, dated 06.05.2020, under Sections 302/307/323/326/324/341/188/ 506/148/149 IPC and Sections 51/54 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, registered at Police Station Pasyana, District Patiala.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that co-accused, Gursewak Singh and who would be seen at the same pedestal had filed CRM-M-16566-2020 seeking anticipatory bail and such petition stands dismissed by this Court vide order dated 07.08.2020.

On the ground of parity itself, the instant petition is dismissed on the same very reasoning as contained in the order dated 07.08.2020 while dismissing CRM-M-16566-2020 (Gursewak Singh Vs. State of Punjab).
