In the present petition filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No. 4 to 7, who are relatives of petitioner No.2 on account of their marriage which has taken place on 16.08.2020 as per Sikh Rites and Rituals at Gurudwara Dashmesh Pita Patshahi Dasvi (Regd.), Village Singha Devi, Tehsil Kharar, District Mohali. The marriage photographs and marriage certificate are annexed as Annexures P-3 & P-4, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 14.08.1999, as per photocopy of the AADHAR card (Annexure P-1) and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 06.07.2001, as per petition and as per photocopy of the AADHAR Card is of 2001, appended as Annexure P-2, respectively.

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It is the case of the petitioners that they got married as per the Sikh rites and rituals and apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents and have filed a representation dated 16.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) with respondent No.2, in this regard.

Notice of motion.

State Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Accordingly, keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have got married and in view of the binding precedent of the ***Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478***, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
