Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 12.06.2020 (Annexure P-9) passed by respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is a remedy of statutory appeal against the order dated 12.06.2020 passed by respondent No.2-Director, Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab and at this stage, he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition, however, with liberty to avail the remedy of appeal against the order dated 12.06.2020. He further submits that the Secretary to Govt., Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab, be directed to hear the appeal of the petitioners on some early possible date.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioners prefer the appeal within a period of one month from today and if the Secretary to Govt., Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab, is comfortable in the present situation of COVID-19 pandemic, the appeal shall be heard at some early date.
