Case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider and appoint petitioner as PTI teacher being more meritorious than respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2 – Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, is directed to look into legal notice (Annexure P-13) of the petitioner in a time-bound manner.

Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 – State.

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Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, to look into legal notice (Annexure P-13) and decide the same within a period of two months from today by passing a speaking order.
