The present petition is filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.55 dated 24.5.2020 under Sections 22 and 25 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar, Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while praying for grant of anticipatory bail submitted that the petitioner was not arrested on the spot. He was enroped only because at an earlier point of time, there was a dispute with the police party when FIR No.34 dated 13.4.2020 under Sections 379/411/273 IPC was registered against the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh has pointed out that the petitioner ran away from the spot. His name was given by the co-accused, who was caught on the spot. Moreover, the motor cycle in which he was riding also belongs to the petitioner. He purchased the same on 10.5.2020 from one Deepak whereas the incident took place on 24.5.2020. He was also identified by HC Jagwinder Singh.

In view of the above, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed accordingly.
