By way of this petition filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C., the petitioner seeks a direction to the Director General of Police, Punjab, to transfer the investigation in FIR No. 56 dated 14.3.2020 on the file of Police Station City-2 Mansa, District Mansa, registered under Sections 302, 148, and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, to another zone. The reason for seeking such transfer is that the jurisdictional police officials are allegedly trying to save their own skin by implicating innocent people.

Mr. Gopal Singh Nahel, learned counsel, states that the petitioner is the wife of one Gurpreet Singh @ Netar, who was implicated in this offence subsequently. There is no explanation forthcoming as to why the petitioner's husband is not coming forward if he himself has a grievance. Even if he is presently incarcerated, that is not reason enough for his wife to take up cudgels on his behalf and fight his battles. The petitioner therefore has no *locus standi* to maintain the present petition.

The petition is accordingly dismissed on this short ground.
