1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentionally and willfully disobeying order dated 14.01.2020, in CWP-10158-2017.
3. Learned DAG, Haryana, states that order dated 14.01.2020, in CWP-10158-2017, has been stayed by Hon'ble the Division Bench in LPA No.807-2020 and that in the circumstances, no further orders are called for in the Contempt Petition and the same may be disposed of as such.
4. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the Contempt Petition and the same may be disposed of as such at this stage while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the Contempt Petition, pursuant to decision of LPA-807-2020., if the circumstances of the case so warrant.
5. The same is not opposed by learned DAG, Haryana.

6. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage, with the liberty as prayed for.
