Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the respondents to release the arrears of dearness allowance along with interest and to decide the Legal Notice dated 15.07.2020 (P-7) in a time bound manner.

At the outset, learned Counsel for the petitioners has stated that his clients would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 15.07.2020 (P-7), served upon respondent Nos.2 to 4 is decided expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ajaivir Singh, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and stated that he has no objection in case the respondent(s) are directed to decide the Legal Notice.

Since prayer is innocuous and there is no objection by the other side also, therefore, this writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to consider and decide the Legal Notice dated 15.07.2020 (P-7), if the same is pending, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within 04 (four) months from today.

Needless to say that in case the petitioners are found entitled for any relief, the same be released at the earliest.
