The petitioners have filed the present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuing a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No.2, to decide notice dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P-6) and to conduct an enquiry against respondent No.5.

On 21.08.2020, learned counsel for the State was requested to seek instructions and assist the Court.

Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A.G. Haryana, has made a statement that the notice shall be decided within a period of 30 days from today. He submits that due to spread of the Novel Coronavirus, the claim of the petitioners could not be decided previously.

Keeping in view the aforesaid statement, the present writ petition is disposed of. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to move an application for its revival, in case the notice (Annexure P-6), is not decided within the afore-said time.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the above-said order.
