Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners who are six in number out of total 11 elected representatives are open to participate in the meeting to be held for nomination of Executive Committee of the Lasara Co-operative Society Ltd., through video conferencing as well as by physical appearance.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has submitted that the State Government has no objection to comply with the direction which this court may pass in the facts and circumstances of this case.

In the present case, the petitioners have filed a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to fix a schedule for holding the meeting for nomination/selection of new Executive Body of the Lasara Cooperative Society Private Limited, Village Lasara, District Ludhiana.

From the pleadings, it is apparent that total 11 members have been elected to the general body. Further election is to take place amongst those 11 elected general body members for election of the members of new executive body. The term of previous executive body has already expired. Members of the new general body were elected in the month of March, 2020.

Keeping in view the fair stand taken by the learned State counsel, it is considered appropriate to direct respondent no.3- Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, to hold the meeting for nomination/ election of new executive body within one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
