Case taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite a message being conveyed by him to his client, the petitioner, he has not surrendered in the trial Court.

The petitioner is an absconder and has been declared a proclaimed offender. Vide last order dated 21.8.2020, he was directed to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from the date of order and then to inform this Court in that regard. It was clarified that in case the revisionist did not surrender before the trial Magistrate within such period of time without any justifiable reason, the revision petition would be liable to be dismissed.

No reason, what to talk of a justifiable reason has been explained for this lapse.

Therefore, the revision petitions stand dismissed.

The complainant has moved CRM-21763-2020 in CRR-1094-2020 that no such settlement has been arrived at between the parties as alleged in the revision petition.

Since the revision petition has been dismissed, the said application has become infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
