Petitioner Dr. Jasbir Singh was working as a Reader and his wife Dr. Suman Singh as Assistant Professor in the Department of Biochemistry, Kurukshetra University. There was inter-se dispute between them and Professor Dr. V. K. Gupta, Head of Department of Biochemistry, due to which interests of the students of the department were suffering. It so transpires that at that moment the petitioner was designated as Chairperson of the Department of Biochemistry and due to that dispute, the impugned order dated 29.6.2010 (**Annexure P-15**) was passed, whereby the Dean of Faculty of Life Sciences was appointed as Chairperson of the Department of Biochemistry.

The grievance raised herein is that the person from different department cannot be appointed as Chairperson.

The writ petition was admitted vide order dated 23.1.2012.

The present application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner for withdrawal of the main case as he wants to approach the university authorities for the redressal of his grievances.

After hearing learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner, the application is allowed and the main writ petition, which is admitted, is taken on Board. The petitioner is permitted to withdraw the main case with liberty to approach the university authorities for the redressal of his grievances.
