1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Claim of the petitioner is for grant of equal pay for equal work in view of instructions issued by the Government of Haryana (Annexure P-4), as well as decision of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in '**State of Punjab and others**versus**Jagjit Singh and others**' i.e. *Civil Appeal No.213 of 2013, decided on 26.10.2016.*

3. Learned counsel states that the petitioner has submitted a representation (Annexure P-7) dated 18.05.2019 in respect of the claim, which is the subject-matter of the instant petition but the same has not been decided, till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-7) dated 18.05.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

5. Mr. Vivek Chauhan, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice and

him, states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation(Annexure P-7) dated 18.05.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible.
