By invoking Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners pray for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 for protection of their life and liberty.

The allegations raised by the petitioners are that they performed legal/valid marriage but against wishes of private respondents No. 4 to 6 at whose behest they are apprehending threat to their life and liberty.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3.

Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Mr. Kuljit Singh, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Heard.

Without going into the question of validity or otherwise of alleged marriage of the petitioners, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to look into grievance of the petitioners and take appropriate action, if any, desired in the given circumstances.
