1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Reply filed by the learned State Counsel, is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondent for deliberate non-compliance with order dated 19.07.2018, in CWP-20637-2015.
4. Learned Addl. AG, Haryana, states that vide order dated 26.10.2020, in LPA No.733 of 2020, Hon'ble the Division Bench has stayed the operation of order dated 19.07.2018, therefore, no orders are called for in the Contempt Petition and the same may be disposed of as such at this stage.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the light of the position as noted above, he does not press the Contempt Petition and the same may be disposed of as such at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the Contempt Petition pursuant to the decision of the LPA, if the circumstances of the case so warrant.

6. The same is not opposed to by learned State Counsel.
7. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the Contempt Petition pursuant to decision in LPA No.733 of 2020, if the circumstances of the case so warrant.
