By way of the present petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner seeks protection of life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.5 who along with her family members, is threatening the petitioner to end his life and falsely implicate him in criminal cases.

It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that representation dated 02.07.2020 (Annexure P-3) has been filed by father of the petitioner.

The dispute arises out of the misconduct of respondent No.5, who is working as ANM at Civil Health Centre, Sujampur where petitioner was posted as Nodal Officer being a Doctor and in-charge of Corona Pandemic. On account of respondent No.5, her son and husband having assaulted the petitioner, an FIR has already been lodged bearing No.0112 dated 15.05.2020 (Annexure P-1).

Respondent No.5, Sarabjit Kaur has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M-13221-2020 on 23.07.2020. From a perusal of the interim order dated 04.06.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed in the said case, it would be clear that the petition filed by her son, Udhay Pratap Singh was dismissed as withdrawn, who is one of the accused in the above-said FIR.

State Counsel submits that the concerned officials shall look into the said representation whereby the petitioner apprehends threat from the family of the said respondent.

Accordingly, with the above assurance of the State Counsel, the present petition is disposed of.
