The husband of the petitioner who was serving as a 'Mali' in the office of the Estate Officer, HUDA Office (respondent No.3), expired on 16.4.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite a period of more than one year having elapsed after death of her husband, all the death-cum-retiral dues have not been paid to the petitioner.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Chief Administrator, HUDA and the Estate Officer, HUDA Office, Sector 4, Kurukshetra

(respondents No.2 and 3) to look into the matter and to dispose of the legal notice dated 8.7.2020 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law at the earliest preferably within a period of 2 months from today. In case anything is found due to be paid to the petitioner, the same be paid within a period of next 2 months thereafter.
