The present petition was converted into a habeas corpus petition on a letter received from one Balwinder Singh alleging therein that the police have picked up his son Jagdeep Singh on 08.08.2020 at 4.12 pm. Thereafter the whereabouts of his son are not known. He has been visiting the police station, however, he has not been disclosed anything about his son.

Notice of motion was issued.

Today Mr. Pawan Sharda, Sr. DAG, Punjab, appearing on behalf of the State, on instructions from ASI Teja Singh, has submitted that the allegations in the complaint made by the father of the alleged detainee, are totally wrong. In fact, Jagdeep Singh, the son of Balwinder Singh, the alleged detainee, was arrested by the police on 11.08.2020 in case FIR No.91 dated 04.06.2020 registered at Police Station City Mansa.

He was produced before the concerned Magistrate within the statutory time. Thereafter the alleged detainee has been remanded to the judicial custody. At present he is lodged in jail.

In view of the above, the present petition does not survive. Hence, the same is dismissed.

However, the petitioner, or the alleged detainee who is now disclosed to be an accused in a criminal case, would be at liberty to avail their legal remedies qua their any grievance, in accordance with law.
