The petitioner is a sole accused in FIR No. 101 dated 07.07.2020 on the file of Police Station Gulha, District Kaithal, registered under Section 15(b) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. By way of this petition, he seeks regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

The petitioner was apprehended in possession of 2 kgs. 400 grams of poppy straw. Admittedly, this would be less than the commercial quantity prescribed under the Act of 1985. No other case was registered against the petitioner, be it under the Act of 1985 or any other penal law, in terms of para-10 of the petition. Mr. Rajneesh Chadwal, learned Assistant

Advocate General, Haryana, concedes this aspect. That being so, custodial

interrogation of the petitioner may no longer be required as he has been in custody since 08.07.2020.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on regular bail upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of ₹20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. Further, the petitioner shall not cause any threat, inducement or promise to any person connected with the case.
