This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus; directing the respondents to reinstate the petitioner and allow him to join duty in pursuance of Office Order No. 945/TI dated 3.3.2020 (Annexure P-2), to treat the period from 3.3.2020 to till date of reinstatement; as duty period and to release the salary and other benefits to the petitioner alongwith interest.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rupinder Singh Jhand, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and has pointed out that the petitioner has joined the office at Ambala today only. The further proceedings qua the petitioner shall be undertaken strictly in accordance with law.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the matter. Hence, the petition is dismissed.

However, it is clarified that in case any action prejudicial to the petitioner is taken by the respondents, then the petitioner shall be at liberty to challenge the same; in accordance with law.
