The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 4 submits that the very appeal pending before the District Judge, Fazilka has already been decided vide judgment and decree dated 01.09.2020. He has filed a copy of the decree, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submits that against the said judgment and decree, the petitioner has already filed a Regular Second Appeal before this Court and in this manner, the parties would be governed by the ultimate outcome in the pending Regular Second Appeal.

Once the very order which is impugned in the present petition is merged into the judgment and decree dated 01.09.2020 passed by learned District Judge, Fazilka and said judgment is challenged by way of Regular Second Appeal, this Court finds that the present civil revision is rendered infructuous, as the parties would be bound by the ultimate decision in the Regular Second Appeal.
