The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Keeping in view the nature of order passed by Additional District Judge, Bhiwani, it appears that the order is innocuous and needs no interference.

Issue of installation of borewell in Killa No.20//106 is subject to partition for which the respondents are entitled to make a statement that they will not take any advantage of borewell as well as construction raised by him during partition proceedings.

In view of aforesaid statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the application was disposed of by the Additional District Judge, Bhiwani with a direction that the defendants shall not claim any benefit of digging of borewell or any construction raised by them in the partition proceedings.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with a liberty to challenge any cause of action subsequently accrued to the petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
