This order shall dispose of the aforesaid three writ petitions as the issue involved therein is common. Insofar as, the impugned order, challenged in these writ petitions is concerned, the same is appealable.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner shall file the appeal within a period of one week which may be ordered to be decided in the time prescribed by this Court, either allowing the petitioner to appear in person or by way of video conferencing/ electronic mode.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the facts of these cases.

These petitions are dismissed as not maintainable. The remedy is available to the petitioner to file an appeal. In case, any such appeal filed by the petitioner within a week before the Appellate Authority, the same shall be decided by the Appellate Authority, within a period of two weeks' by giving a personal hearing or by way of video conferencing.
