Petitioner Amritpal Singh has come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner and that of his girl friend Jashanpreet Kaur @ Jashan at the hands of private respondents.

Service of private respondents is dispensed with.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the records, the present petition stands disposed of with the directions to the official respondents to ensure due protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents and to act on his representation Annexure P/1 fully in accordance with law, expeditiously. However, this will not be construed as bestowing of legitimacy of relationship so claimed by the petitioner with Jashanpreet Kaur @ Jashan.
