LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioner seeks directions to respondents no.2 and 3 to not implicate him in false and frivolous cases in respect to recovery of some mobile phones in the bathroom of jail premises, where he is confined. It is further prayed that respondents no.2 and 3 be directed not to register any case against the petitioner on the basis of false allegations against the petitioner.

Petitioner is currently confined in jail at Patiala, in case FIR No. 29 dated 03.02.2018, under Sections 365, 302, 201, 34 IPC, Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala. Various allegations have been raised in the present petition, stating that the jail authorities are trying to implicate the petitioner in false cases regarding recovery of some mobile phones.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the file with his assistance.

In my considered opinion, no ground whatsoever is made out for any interference in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C, inasmuch as, there cannot be any directions, which can be issued to the authorities for not proceeding against the petitioner and register the FIR, merely because the allegations, are perceived to be false by the petitioner. There is indeed no such justification. It is not for this Court, in exercise of jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C., to return a finding as to whether the recovery of mobile phones etc., if any, is incorrect, false or otherwise.

Consequently, this petition being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
