The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 for registration of case against the private respondents for committing breach of trust, causing threats to the petitioner and his family members and making an attempt to kill the petitioner on 11.07.2018 by administering poison to him in the police station Nurmahal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondent No.5 had filed a false complaint against the petitioner, following which he was called in the police station and the private respondents had administered the poison to him.

Learned State counsel assisted by the learned counsel for respondents No.5 to 8 states that as per the statement of doctor, there was no sign of poison and the complaint of the petitioner has been filed.

Learned State counsel further points out that the complaints filed by Dharminder Singh and Nirmal Singh against the petitioner, have also been filed.

In view of the above facts, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the concerned SSP, if there is any danger to him as well as his family at the hands of the private respondents.
