Notice in the present petition was issued by this Court on 01.10.2020 by passing a detailed order. The contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner, learned State counsel and learned counsel for the complainant were duly considered while passing the aforesaid order dated 01.10.2020 wherein the petitioner was granted interim protection subject to his joining of investigation and to co-operate with the investigation process. He has further submitted that while granting the interim protection the

condition was imposed that the petitioner would not leave the country without the permission of the Court and would also surrender his passport, if any.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sachin has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is fully co-operating with the investigation process. Therefore, he has further submitted on instructions that the petitioner is not required for custodial investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel has submitted that so far as the condition of submitting of the passport is concerned, the petitioner does not own any passport.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 01.10.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
