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Mr. Sucha Singh, Assistant-cum-Record Keeper of the Law Officer, Punjab Roadways, Ludhiana appearing with Mr. RS Khaira, AAG, Punjab states that Saudagar Singh-Petitioner herein has since died. It is further stated by him that his wife has also died.

The original challenge in the writ petition was to the order of the Labour Court, Ludhiana passed on an application under Section 33-C (2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 wherein the petitioner had claimed arrears on account of notional increments from 1987 to 1994.

It is found from the record that counsel, who filed this writ petition, has since expired. Notice was issued to the appellant and it was received back unserved with the report 'not residing at the given address.' It is today stated as notice above that the petitioner as also his wife have since died. None has come forward to bring on record the LRs. In the circumstances, this writ petition is ordered to be consigned to record with liberty to get it revived by moving an appropriate application, if need be.
