Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Custody certificate of the petitioner has been filed. Same is taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place.

Through this second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.150 dated 25.06.2018, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Petitioner is facing trial in the aforesaid FIR on the allegations that on 25.06.2018 he was apprehended with conscious possession of 5000 tablets of Tramadol Hydrochloride, without any permit or licence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that

petitioner is in custody since 25.06.2018. Conclusion of trial may take a sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner any more in jail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner Jagjit Singh is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, if not required in any other case, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
