Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.28 dated 30.04.2019, under Sections 363, 366, 436 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot.

Perusal of the file shows that the petitioners were directed to join investigation vide order dated 23.05.2019 and in case of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on interim bail. It was also observed that in case the petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Sections 438(2) (i) to (iv) Cr.P.C., failing which they shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to them.

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On 27.08.2019, counsel for the State had brought to the notice of the Court that some of the petitioners have not joined the investigation, on which petitioners were again directed to associate themselves with the investigation and appear before the Investigating Officer as and when required.

As per the instructions received by learned counsel for the State from ASI Rajesh Kumar, P.S. Sujanpur, District Pathankot, petitioners have yet not joined the investigation and are not cooperating. Counsel for the State prays for dismissal of the present petition.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Therefore, the present petition stands dismissed.
