The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner has approached this Court for anticipatory bail on third occasion without disclosing the factum of earlier two petitions. CRM-M No.1419 of 2020 was dismissed vide order dated 31.01.2020. Petitioner filed CRM-M No.15699 of 2020 without disclosing the factum of order dated 31.01.2020 passed in CRM-M No.1419 of 2020. The said petition was got dismissed as withdrawn as the petitioner showed his intention to surrender before the Court and then avail his remedy in accordance with

law. The order to that effect was passed on 01.09.2020. This time the petitioner has concealed both the orders dated 31.01.2020 and 01.09.2020 passed in the earlier two petitions.

Ms. Sukhbir Kaur, Advocate appearing on behalf of Mr. Raj Kumar Arya, Advocate for the petitioner submits that in fact the present petition was typed on 19.08.2020 and office of learned counsel for the petitioner was not informed about the order dated 01.09.2020 passed in CRM-M No.15699 of 2020. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition in view of order dated 01.09.2020 passed in CRM-M No.15699 of 2020.

The practice of filing repeated petition(s) for grant of anticipatory bail without disclosing the earlier petitions/orders has to be deprecated.

In view of aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
