The petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.222 dated 24.8.2019, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act,1985(Act No.61 of the year 1985), , at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith the co-accused were allegedly apprehended with 6500 tablets of Cavilodol 100 (salt Tramadol Hydrochloride). The recovery from the petitioner and his co-accused falls in commercial category. The report from the Forensic Science Laboratory has been received, which also prove that the tablets did contain prohibited substance, Tramadol Hydrochloride.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant bail to the petitioner is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
