The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

This petition has been filed for issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents to safeguard the rights of the petitioner in the context of protection of her life and personal liberty.

FIR No.24 dated 27.2.2020 under Sections 323/ 452/ 506/ 148/ 149 IPC was registered against the petitioner party at Police Station Beas. Petitioner also lodged DDR No.17 dated 19.6.2020 in respect of the same occurrence. Petitioner and her co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail by the

Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide orders dated 17.3.2020 and 21.7.2020. Petitioner has alleged that the opposite party is enjoying the political clout of the ruling party and has been pressurizing the petitioner to enter into settlement with them. At their instance, police used to call the petitioner every day and force her to sit in the police station till late night.

For the grievance in question, petitioner has already approached respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 26.7.2020 (Annexure P-5), but no action has been taken by respondent No.2 so far.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon any response from the respondents as no order prejudicial to interest of any party is being passed.

In view of above, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation filed by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law

without being influenced by any statement of fact recorded herein above.

It would be appreciated if the representation filed by the petitioner is decided within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
