1. Appearing on advance notice, Mr. Sahil Sharma, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab appearing for the Respondents informs the Court that the reasons for rejection of the Petitioners' bid during technical evaluation has been communicated to the Petitioners by email. He states that additionally those reasons will also be sent to the email id of the Counsel for the Petitioners today itself.

2. In that view of the matter, Mr. Gaurav Chopra, learned Counsel for the Petitioners seeks leave to withdraw this writ petition, with liberty to file an

appeal before the competent authority in terms of clause 16 of the Punjab Foodgrains Labour and Cartage Policy 2020-21 against the rejection of their bid. The appeal, if so filed, will be decided as expeditiously as possible and, in any event, not later than one week after its receipt by the competent authority. Such decision will be communicated to the Petitioners within 3 days thereafter.

3. It will be open to the Petitioners, if aggrieved by such decision, to seek appropriate remedies in accordance with law.

4. The petition is disposed of in the above terms.
