Case taken up through video conferencing.

Petitioner – Hari Singh, who had been serving as Commercial Assistant in Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as DHBVNL) was proceeded against departmentally for a misconduct on account of negligence and carelessness etc. causing financial loss running into lakhs of rupees to DHBVNL. On conclusion of inquiry, the report was submitted concluding that the misconduct on the part of the petitioner stood proved. Acting on such report, Superintending Engineer, DHBVNL vide order dated 29.7.2020 had dismissed the petitioner from service.

Aggrieved by that order, the petitioner is said to have filed an appeal dated 4.8.2020 before the Appellate Authority along with the stay application but no order thereon is said to have been passed till date.

By way of filing the present civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to decide the stay application filed along with the main appeal dated 4.8.2020 against the impugned order dated 29.7.2020.

Heard.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent to decide the appeal/stay application within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
