On 26.08.2020, following order was passed:-

“ Counsel for the State has received instructions from the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, according to which, the Instructions dated 10.08.2020 have been modified and now the case would be heard by the competent Authority following the social distancing norms as fixed by the Government of India, Department of Home. She informs that Ms. Poonam Nara, Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, delegated the powers of the Registrar, has been assigned the appeal of the petitioner which will be heard on 02.09.2020.

Counsel for the petitioner has an apprehension that the case of the petitioner would not be heard on the said date, which this Court, at this stage, finds to be unacceptable as the Court is sanguine that the statement, which has been given by the learned counsel for the State, will be honoured by the concerned authority.

Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that Ms.Poonam Nara, Additional Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, has, after hearing counsel for the petitioners, passed the order dated 02.09.2020.
