Petitioner Sanjeev Kumar Gadi and 02 others have brought the instant civil writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents i.e. State of Haryana through its Secretary, Director State Transport, Haryana, Addl. Transport Commissioner, Haryana and Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Fatehabad through ADC to extend the validity of offer of Allotment/LOI dated 01.06.2020 (Annexures P1 to P-3) beyond 90 days without any surcharge to another 90 days taking into consideration the difficult time due to COVID-19 pandemic or directing respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 16.07.2020 (Annexure P7) by taking into consideration all these prevailing circumstances.

Mr. Rajiv Sidhu, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Heard.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and in order to avoid unnecessary litigation between the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of, directing the respondents to consider the representation (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner and decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from today. However, in case, the petitioners still feel aggrieved after disposal of the representation, they may approach the Court again for seeking their remedy in accordance with law.
