Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is second petition for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in a criminal case arising from FIR No.71, dated 21.05.2018, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, Punjab.

As per the case of the prosecution, 5 accused were apprehended with 1100 grams of Tramadol Hydrochloride powder. The petitioner stands convicted in FIR No.132 dated 23.08.2015 under Section 21/59 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. Apart therefrom, there is one more case under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. There are also 2 cases under Indian Penal Code, 1860 including one U/s 302 IPC.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

However, the learned trial court is requested to make a sincere endeavour to conclude the trial expeditiously after the normal functioning of the Courts resume.
