The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Petitioner has filed the present revision petition for setting aside the order dated 05.03.2020 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur as well as order dated 01.02.2019 passed by learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Sangrur, whereby his prayer for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.48, dated 20.06.2018, under Sections 307, 341, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Sadar, Amhedgarh, has been declined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 26.08.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 26.08.2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
