The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial enquiry in the representation dated 14.2.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Petitioner has filed the aforesaid representation in the context of fraud in the Central Cooperative Bank, Branch Office Davida Ahrana, Hoshiarpur. Petitioner and his son are aggrieved of the said fraud as the petitioner has received a notice from the bank on 24.1.2020 in the name of his son, stating that his son is member of Noor Self Health Group and loan of Rs.2,70,000/- was obtained from the bank for composite

manure on 29.8.2014. The instalments of the loan were shown pending and an amount of Rs.90,000/- was fastened as defaulter amount and the same was required to be paid within a period 15 days. In the event of failure, initiation of recovery proceedings were threatened. According to the petitioner, his son is living in Australia since the year 2013 and there was no occasion for him to avail such loan from the bank.

Since no complaint under Section 154 Cr.P.C. has been made before the SHO, therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw this petition with liberty to file appropriate complaint before the SHO in terms of Section 154 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
