By invoking Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners (both male) seek protection of their life and personal liberty allegedly attacked by private respondents No.6 to 12, family members of the petitioners.

As per allegations made in the petition, petitioners are known to each other since four years and want to live in relationship and spend their life together which is against liking of private respondents.

Without examining the correctness of allegations made in the petition and with regard to relationship between the petitioners, the petition

stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into grievance of the petitioners and take appropriate action warranted in the circumstances, in accordance with law, so that life and liberty of the petitioners is not risked at the hands of private respondents.
