1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 13.02.2020, legal notice dated 12.12.2019 has been decided and part of the claim accepted and payment in respect thereto made to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, he does not press the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order, deciding the legal notice dated 12.12.2019, in accordance with law, *qua* the claim, which has been rejected, including the claim for interest.
