Briefly, FIR No.50 dated 01.07.2019 under Sections 22 & 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 has been registered at Police Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib, against the petitioner in pursuance of recovery of 24 injections of Buprenorphine. The quantity of the contraband falls in the category of commercial quantity. As such, stringent provisions of Section 37 of the NDPS Act come into play. There is nothing to suggest that the petitioner has not committed the offence and is not likely to commit the offence while on bail. It is also the third bail application of the petitioner for bail. Earlier two applications were dismissed as withdrawn vide orders dated 04.03.2020 and 09.07.2020.
