The petitioners in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seek directions to official respondents to protect their life and liberty from the hands of the private respondents and their associates, on account of having married on 20.08.2020.

The private respondents are relatives of both the petitioners. In view of the directions dated 26.08.2020 to look into the representation dated 20.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) and take necessary action in accordance with law, if so required, Mr. Sullar, on instructions received from SI Satinder Kaur, submits that the statements of the parties have been recorded. He further points out that they are living happily after marriage and, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, keeping in view of the above the petition is disposed off by binding the State to give protection if required to the petitioners on the above said account.
