The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.181 dated 5.6.2020 registered under Sections 376, 384, 506, 120-B, 34 IPC, Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktar Sahib.

It is evident from the perusal of the FIR that the complainant was having affair with the petitioner and she was engaged with him. Thereafter, it looks like things went wrong and the petitioner has backed out of the marriage.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that he was always ready to marry her but it was she who backed out as he found some sachets of Chiita in her purse.

Be that as it may, the fact is that it is a matter of trial whether offence as alleged in the present circumstances made out or not.

As of now, the petitioner is entitled for grant of bail.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
